

Fireworks Ordinance Ordinance 4 of 2019

Section 4. Prohibited Acts

No person shall ignite, discharge, or use consumer fireworks within East Bay Charter Township at any time, except during any of the following days and times:

- (a) After 11am on December 31st and until 1am on January 1st.
- (b) After 11am and until 11:45pm on the Saturday and Sunday immediately proceeding Memorial Day.
- (c) After 11am and until 11:45pm on June 29th through July 4th.
- (d) If July 5th falls on a Friday or Saturday, then after 11am and until 11:45pm on July 5th.
- (e) After 11am and until 11:45pm on the Saturday and Sunday immediately proceeding Labor Day.

Noise OrdinanceOrdinance 3 of 2005

Section 2. Prohibited Acts

The following acts and activities are declared to be noise disturbances and are prohibited. This enumeration shall not be deemed exclusive:

- (a) The playing of any radio, television, phonograph, other sound reproductive device, or musical instrument in such a manner or at such a volume as to be sufficiently audible to annoy or disturb the quiet, comfort, or repose of persons in the vicinity.
- (b) The keeping of any animal or bird which, by causing frequent or long continued noice, shall disturb the quiet, comfort, or repose of persons in the vicinity.
- (c) The use of any motor vehicle, including motocycles, in such a manner as to create a disturbing noise, including, but not limited to, the screeching of tires and discharge into the open air of exhaust from the engine without a sufficient muffler.
- (d) Shouting or other raucous or boisterous behavior for an unreasonable length of time.

Please be mindful of where you park. Motor vehicles, boats, campers and trailers shall be parked on the short-term rental property and not parked along any public or private roadway. Any vehicles parked along the roadway may be ticketed or towed.



All watercraft to be cleaned and washed prior to use per Michigan DNR recommendations.



All pets must be secured in the premises or on a leash per MCL 287.262, the Michigan Leash Law.



Trash, rubbish, refuse, or garbage may not be left within public view, except in proper waste or recycling containers for the purpose of collection or disposal. No commercial dumpsters shall be allowed on the property containing the short-term rental.
