**EAST BAY CHARTER TOWNSHIP
FIRE PREVENTION ORDINANCE
INTERNATIONAL FIRE CODE
Ordinance No. 2005-5**

An ordinance of East Bay Charter Township adopting the *International Fire Code 2006 Edition*, regulating and governing the safeguarding of life and property from fire and explosion hazards arising from the storage, handling and use of hazardous substances, materials and devices, and from conditions hazardous to life or property in the occupancy of buildings and premises in East Bay Charter Township; providing for the issuance of permits for hazardous uses or operations; repealing all other ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict therewith.

The Board of Trustees of East Bay Charter Township ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Adoption of the International Fire Code 2006 Edition. That a certain document, two (2) copies of which are on file at the office of the East Bay Charter Township, being marked and designated as the International Fire Code 2006 Edition, Including Appendix Chapters A through G, As published by the International Code Council, is adopted as the Fire Prevention Ordinance of East Bay Charter Township for regulating the safeguarding of life and property from the fire and explosion hazards arising from the storage, handling and use of hazardous substances, materials and devices, and from conditions hazardous to life or property in the occupancy of buildings or premises in East Bay Charter Township and providing for the issuance of permits for hazardous uses and operations; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, conditions and terms of the International Fire Code 2006 Edition and any future amendments to that code, published by the International Code Council, on file in the office of the East Bay Charter Township Clerk are adopted and made a part of this ordinance as if fully set forth in this ordinance, with the additions, insertions, deletions and changes, if any, prescribed in Section 2 of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. International Fire Code 2006 Edition changes. The following sections of the International Fire Code 2006 Edition, adopted in Section 1, are added, deleted, or changed as follows:

101.1 Title. These regulations shall be known as the *Fire Prevention Ordinance of East Bay Charter Township*, are referred to below as "this code."

103.1 General. The department of fire prevention is established within the jurisdiction under the direction of the Grand Traverse Metro Fire Department Board. The Grand Traverse Metro Fire Chief (and/or his/her designate(s)) shall be named the Fire Code Official. The function of the Fire Code Official shall be the implementation, administration and enforcement of the provisions of this code. The fire code official shall not be removed from office except for cause and after full opportunity to be heard on specific and relevant charges by and before the appointing authority.

105.7.14 New Construction. Any owner or authorized agent who intends to construct, enlarge, alter, repair, remove, convert or replace any fire alarm and detection system and related equipment, fire suppression system and related equipment including fire pump, standpipe systems and water supply piping and hydrants, the installation of which is regulated by this code, or to cause any such work to be done, shall first make application to the fire code official and obtain the required permit.
